Dear Attorneys and Court Staff,

Based upon our receipt of the First Emergency Order Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster issued by the Texas Supreme Court and Court of Criminal Appeals of Texas, the 76th/276th District Court revises its court plan as follows:

Beginning March 17, 2020 until May 11, 2020 the 76th and 276th Courts will only hear the following cases:


1. Jail pleas
2. Juvenile detention/adjudication hearings
3. Writs of Habeas Corpus
4. Protective Orders
5. Emergency family law cases

The listed cases will only be heard by special setting. If you have a need for one of those hearings, please contact the court and the need will be evaluated on a case by case basis, and a special date and time will be scheduled. If you currently have settings during this time period, they are cancelled effectively immediately and will need to be rescheduled on or after May 11, 2020. Please note, that this is a fluid situation and the schedule may be revised further based upon OCA and CDC guidelines. The court strongly suggests that all contested temporary and final family law matters attempt mediation before contacting the court for a setting.


This court plan does not include CPS Court and Attorney General Court cases. The Judges for those courts will implement their own court plans.

Further due to recommendations by the CDC and advisory opinions from the Office of Court Administration, effective today, March 16, 2020, all attorneys and court staff traveling on

domestic or international flights will be required to have a 14 day waiting period before participating in Court matters. Court staff and attorneys are encouraged to not fly domestically or internationally. If you must travel, please contact the Judges Office by email.
